Please join the Harrisburg and Hershey Civil War Roundtables on Saturday May 19, 2012 as we visit the first major battlefield of the American Civil War. We will visit many of the sites on this battlefield; such as Blackburn's Ford, The Wilmer McLean House, Mitchell's Ford, Signal Hill, Stone Bridge, Sudly Springs Ford, Matthew's Hill and Henry House Hill.

Our historian/guide will be Matt Atkinson. A native Mississippian and long time National Battlefield Park Ranger, Matt has served at Vicksburg as well as Gettysburg. He is an alumnus of the University of Mississippi, where he received a Bachelor of Business Administration and a Bachelor of Arts Degree (History). Matt currently is a graduate student at the University's Monroe campus where he is pursuing his master's degree in history.

The price of this fieldtrip is \$89. This includes deluxe bus transportation from pick up points in Hummelstown (Lower Dauphin High School) and Camp Hill (Radisson Hotel and Conference Center), all entrance fees as well as driver tip. Lunch and dinner will be on your own.
